MOSQUITO SPRAYING – The Town is again participating in the mosquito control program offered by the Maryland Department of Agriculture and QAC Department of Public Works. The program includes monitoring of mosquito populations and spraying when deemed necessary by a MDA Inspector. Spraying will take place only on Sundays between the hours of 7pm (Sunday) to 6am (Monday). Residents are asked to remain indoors when you see or hear the spray truck as the technicians cannot spray while people are present outside. FIRE HYDRANTS NOT FOR COMMERCIAL USE – There has been an increase in commercial vehicles obtaining water from the Town’s fire hydrants, mainly on the south side of Rt. 301 on Del Rhodes and near the Outlets. **With the exception of Video Pipe, the contractor currently doing sewer line camera work, the Town has not given any company permission to obtain water from our hydrants.** We would appreciate your help in identifying any commercial vehicle/tank you see obtaining water from a hydrant, with the exception of the fire department. If possible, note any name, phone number, vehicle description and/or tag number from the vehicle obtaining water and provide it to the Town Office.

WREATHS ACROSS AMERICA – The Town is in support of the “Wreaths Across America” fundraiser for the Federated Garden Clubs of Maryland. Wreaths Across America places wreaths on graves at 1200 locations throughout the U.S. The Federated Garden Clubs of Maryland is seeking donations to place wreaths on every grave at the Eastern Shore Veterans Cemetery in Hurlock, MD on December 15, 2018. Wreaths Across America donates 1 wreath for every 2 purchased. The goal is to reach 5,000 wreaths purchased, for a total of 7,500 wreaths total. This will be enough wreaths for all gravesites at the cemetery to be honored.
