



ELECTION RESULTS – The election for Queenstown Commissioner was held on November 5, 2018 and the results are as follows: Thomas Willis, Jr. – 52 votes; Write-In candidate Paul Cain, Jr. – 48 votes.

TREE LIGHTING – Please join us for a festive evening at the Queenstown Tree Lighting on November 30, 2018 at 7pm in the Town Center. Enjoy free refreshments and holiday caroling with your fellow neighbors as we light the Town Tree!

SIDEWALKS – A reminder that parking of any vehicles or trailers on sidewalks is prohibited in the Town. Sidewalks must be kept free of any blockages or obstructions so that they may be safely used by pedestrians.

OPEN BURNING – A reminder that any open burning of leaves, branches, trash, etc. is prohibited in the Town, this includes the use of “burn barrels”. Home fire pits for recreational use are allowed. The Town offers bulk pickup service every Monday which can be a useful way to dispose of any fallen leaves and twigs/branches that come with the changing seasons.

BULK PICKUP – A reminder that Town bulk pickup is every Monday. (Tuesday if Monday is a holiday) Please have bulk items out and ready for pickup the day before to ensure they are collected. Do not put items out for pickup earlier than Saturday. Also a reminder that bulk pickup may take 2 days to complete depending on the amount of bulk placed town wide. PROPERTY MAINTENANCE – A reminder that yards should be kept free of junk, trash and debris, and grass and weeds should be kept trimmed to 6 inches or less. The Town has received complaints regarding property maintenance violations at several properties and will become more vigilant in issuing notices and fines for violations of the Property Maintenance Code. RECYCLING DAYS – Upcoming scheduled recycling days: Nov. 14, Nov. 28, Dec. 12. Recycle bins should be put out facing the street (wheels facing the yard). Reminder, recycling bins are for recycling only. Recycle bins used for trash will not be collected during trash or recycling collection.

HOLIDAY OFFICE/SERVICE SCHEDULE – The Town Office will be closed on Monday, November 12 for Veterans Day. Bulk Pickup will be on Tuesday, November 13 that week. Town Office will also be closed on Thursday, November 22 and Friday, November 23 for Thanksgiving. Trash Pickup will be on Saturday, November 24 that week.
