WATER SHUT-OFF POLICY - As we advised previously, beginning with January, the Town has implemented a new policy to shut off water to those who are delinquent in paying their water and sewer bills. Every month, we will send out notifications of delinquency and scheduled shut off dates to our delinquent customers. This is now a monthly routine, and customers should work to keep their accounts current to avoid shut off. OPEN YARD BURNING – A reminder that open yard burning is prohibited within the Town. Please dispose of any leaves, branches, paper, trash, etc. by using the Bulk Pickup, Recycling, or Trash Collection services the Town offers. Information on these services can be found at www.queenstown-md.com.

SEWER LINE CONNECTIONS – A reminder that the connection of sump pumps or down spouts to sewer lines is a violation of the Town Code. The Town has recently experienced an influx of groundwater in the sewer lines and may be conducting future smoke testing of the sewer lines to determine the sources of infiltration and any unauthorized connections to sewer lines.

WATER/SEWER LINE TESTING - Before you sell your property, it is your responsibility to have the water and sewer lines tested. The Town will not sign off on any deeds of transfer unless the testing has been completed and passed. Please contact the Town Office for more information.

OFFICE CLOSING - The Town Office will be closed on Friday, March 30th, in observance of Good Friday. There will be no interruption of recycle and/or trash collection that week.
