TOWN HALL MEETING – The Town will be holding a “Town Hall” style meeting on February 20 at 7pm at the Calvary United Methodist Church at 7113 Maryland Ave. The meeting will be an opportunity for interested residents to discuss ideas and concerns with the Town Commissioners, Planning Commission, and QAC Sheriff’s Dept. in an informal and personal setting.

TREE PRUNING SCHEDULED – Beginning in March, Delmarva Power will begin routine scheduled pruning of trees near power lines in Queenstown. This maintenance is performed as is necessary to prevent power outages due to tree branches contacting or falling on power lines. BOARD OF APPEALS CONSIDERATION – Anyone with interest in serving as an alternate on the Board of Appeals is asked to send a letter of intent to the Town Office in writing or through email no later than Feb. 22, 2019.

CUSTOMER INFO UPDATES – The Town occasionally updates records to keep customer/resident information on file accurate and are asking that you please provide current info on the form included on the back of your water bill. SIDEWALKS – A reminder that parking of vehicles or trailers on sidewalks is prohibited in the Town. Sidewalks must be kept clear of any obstructions so that they can be safely used by pedestrians.

WATER/SEWER TESTING REQUIREMENTS – A reminder that properties being sold or transferred in town are required to have water and sewer line tests performed at the seller’s expense prior to transfer. The results of these tests are required before the Town will sign off on a deed.
