

**TOWN OF QUEENSTOWN
BULK COLLECTION REGULATIONS
EVERY MONDAY**

1. Should Monday be a major holiday, collection will be on Tuesday of that week.
2. Place items street side for collection no earlier than 2 days before collection day and no later than 6 AM on collection day. If you place items out after that time, they may not get collected. Should you miss collection, items will not be collected until the following week. Remember to remove any items not collected from the street.
3. Occasionally the volume of bulk placed out town wide may require more than one day collection. Allow us 3 days to have all items removed.
4. Small “junk” items must be bagged.
5. Brush, metals, and lumber (small amounts, see #8), must be separated from each other and all other items. Form separate piles each for brush, metals, and lumber.
6. Twigs, grass clippings, and leaves must be bagged in clear bags or in paper yard bags marked with your address. No wheelbarrows, baskets, or trash cans full of loose items. Do not mix anything else in with these items (no paper, plastic, etc. – NOTHING!)
7. Tree limbs, branches, lumber, etc. must be cut to 5’ or less in length and 6” or less in diameter. If you remove a tree from your property, please haul it away. Town employees will not pick up large tree remains more than 5’ in length and 6” in diameter.
8. If you are performing any new construction on your property, you must provide your own dumpster for construction debris, or haul it away. The Town will not collect this debris, nor will the trash collector.
9. Appliances & furniture will be collected. Appliances with coolants (a/c, freezers, etc.) will be collected free of charge at this time. REMOVE DOORS FROM APPLIANCES.
10. No cardboard will be collected during bulk collection. It will be collected with recyclable items. Please recycle as much as possible!
11. No tires will be collected.
12. No vehicle batteries will be collected.
13. No motor oil will be collected by the Town or trash collector. All motor oil must be disposed of properly. Call the Queen Anne’s County Dept. of Public Works at 410-758-0925 with questions regarding disposal.
14. No oil based paint (cans or buckets) will be collected. Latex paint is accepted provided sand or kitty litter is mixed into any remaining paint in the container and allowed to dry.
