

RESOLUTION NO. 20-107

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF QUEENSTOWN TO
ADOPT FEE FOR PERMITS FOR USE OF THE TOWN BOAT RAMP**

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Queenstown are authorized to adopt such legislation as it may deem necessary for the protection and preservation of the town's property and for the protection and promotion of health and safety of town employees and citizens; and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 20-07, the Commissioners of Queenstown adopted regulations for the use of the Town Boat Ramp, which are set forth in Section 13.4 of the Queenstown Code, the purpose of which is to protect the health, safety and welfare of the Town and prevent damage to Town property; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 13.4 of the Queenstown Code, the Commissioners of Queenstown have the authority to enact a resolution establishing a fee schedule for the administration of permits to use the Town Boat Ramp; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Queenstown have determined that it is desirable and in the public interest to adopt a schedule of fees as provided by Section 13.4 of the Queenstown Code.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Commissioners of Queenstown as follows:

Boat Ramp Permit Fees

Town of Queenstown Resident	\$15.00
Non-Resident	\$50.00

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above-referenced fees may be incorporated into a comprehensive schedule of Town administrative fees as adopted by the Commissioners of Queenstown and amended from time to time.
