**BOAT RAMP POLICY CHANGE** – Effective March 24, the Commissioners passed Resolution 21-101 which restricted the Skipjack Cove Lane Boat Landing to Town residents only and established a Boat Landing Permit required to use the facility. Residents who wish to park or launch boats at the landing are required to display a valid Landing Permit on their vehicle. Permits can be obtained from the Town Office for a fee of \$25.00.

**PROPERTY MAINTENANCE** – A reminder as Spring weather arrives that lawns must be maintained at a height of 6 inches or less. Please avoid blowing leaves and cut grass onto roadways and sidewalks. Also, a reminder that open burning (including leaves) is prohibited within the Town. The Town offers bulk pickup service every Monday and will gladly collect any bagged leaves, grass and yard debris left out for pickup. Also, a reminder that boats/boat trailers must be stored in the side or rear yards of properties and should not be stored in the front yards of properties including driveways. Please avoid blocking of any sidewalks so that residents may use them safely.
