TOWN OFFICE ADMINISTRATIVE DAY CLOSING – The Town Office will be closed for administrative purposes on Wednesday, August 11, 2021. Normal Town Office hours will resume on Thursday, August 12, 2021.

ANNUAL TOWN YARD SALE – We are happy to announce the return of the annual Queenstown Town Yard Sale! The yard sale will take place on Saturday, October 23, 2021, with a rain date of Sunday, October 24. More information to follow in next month's newsletter.

DOCK AND RAMP IMPROVEMENTS – The Town will soon begin work on improvements to the First and Second Avenue Boat Docks and the Skipjack Cove Landing Area. During this work, access to these areas may be affected. Work is expected to begin in late September or early October. More information will be provided to current slip holders and landing permit holders, in the newsletter and on the Town website once a timeframe for the projects is established.

DID YOU KNOW?? – The Queenstown Property Maintenance Code Chapter 3, Section 302.8 states: "...inoperative or unlicensed motor vehicles shall not be parked, kept or stored on any premises, and vehicles shall not at any time be in a state of major disassembly, disrepair, or in the process of being stripped or dismantled. Painting of vehicles is prohibited unless conducted inside an approved spray booth. A vehicle of any type is permitted to undergo major overhaul, including body work, provided that such work is performed inside a structure or similarly enclosed area designed and approved for such purposes." The Town has established a Code Enforcement Officer to enforce property maintenance and other codes within the town and will be issuing letters for violations when necessary.
