COMMISSIONER'S CORNER-

- The Commissioners recently held a public hearing on Ordinance 21-07, which establishes standards for storing/parking of recreational equipment and vehicles on properties and in front yard driveways. The ordinance was adopted on 11/17/21 and may be found on our website at www.queenstown-md.com.
- A public hearing was also held on Ordinance 21-06, which would establish new fencing standards. After receiving public comment on the ordinance, further changes to the ordinance have been considered. The ordinance will be discussed, and potentially adopted, at the December 7th Commissioners meeting.
- Contracts for dredge work at the Town Docks and improvements to the boat ramp have been awarded. Work on both projects is expected to begin during the winter months. Any boaters that will be affected by the work will be notified in advance of the contractor starting.
- The Commissioners are seeking residents who may be interested in serving on an Activities Committee. The committee would be under the direction of the Town Commissioners for the purpose of proposing ideas for, and potential planning of, events and recreational activities in the town.
