SIDEWALK SAFETY - We would like to remind all residents during the winter weather season to keep sidewalks clear to provide safe walking paths throughout the town. Section 19-59 (3) of the Town Charter requires homeowners to keep all sidewalks abutting their properties clear of any obstructions including ice and snow.

DID YOU KNOW?? - Queen Anne's County Code Ch. 9 Sec. 9-18 (which Queenstown follows) requires property owner's permission prior to allowing dogs to defecate on private property, even if waste is immediately removed. We ask that all residents please clean up after your dog when walking around Town. Waste stations are provided throughout Town for bagging and disposing of dog waste.
