### COMMISSIONER'S UPDATES -

- The Commissioners recently approved a franchise agreement with Comcast to provide cable tv and internet service to the Town. This service will be another option in addition to the services currently provided by Breezeline. Comcast is expected to begin installation of service lines in the next few weeks.
- Improvements at the Town docks will continue with installation of new water supply lines and paving of the dock areas. Work is expected to be completed by the end of Fall and is 100% grant funded.

**TOWN COMMISSIONER ELECTION** - The upcoming election for Queenstown Town Commissioner will take place on Monday, November 6, 2023, from 3pm to 8pm. Nominations for Commissioner will begin Friday, September 8, 2023, and will end at noon on Friday, October 6, 2023. The last day to register to vote in the election is Friday, October 20, 2023. The last day to file for absentee voting is Monday, October 30, 2023.

**NEW PUBLIC WORKS EMPLOYEE** - The Town has hired a new Public Works employee, Mr. George Glew, who will soon become a common face around the Town. If you see Mr. Glew while out and about, please welcome him to Queenstown!

**DID YOU KNOW??** - Queenstown Town Code Chapter 11, Section 11.1 (A) states: "It shall be unlawful for any person to openly burn leaves, papers, garbage, branches, wood, and other items within the corporate limits of Queenstown." As Fall soon approaches, we remind all residents that any fallen yard debris such as leaves, branches, twigs, etc. will gladly be collected by the Town during Monday bulk collection. Recycling collection is every other Wednesday and Trash collection is every Friday. Please dispose of all yard debris, recycling and trash properly. Burning of wood in small, enclosed fire pits is permitted for personal recreational use.
