COMMISSIONER'S UPDATES -

- The November and December Commissioners Meetings will follow an altered schedule with one meeting per month. Schedules will be available in the November newsletter. Schedule info can also be found at www.queenstown-md.com.
- The Commissioners will hold a public hearing on October 25 at 6 pm at the Town Office on the proposed franchise renewal agreement for Breezeline for the purpose of receiving comments on the proposed renewal of the franchise. Public comments are encouraged.
- The Improvements at the Town docks will continue with installation of new water supply lines and paving of the dock areas. Work is expected to be completed by the end of Fall and is 100% grant funded.
- Paving of Wall Street & Short Street will tentatively begin the end of October. This is the final phase of the water line replacement project that began over the summer. Residents in those areas will be advised when a start date is scheduled.

The siren may also be used to alert the public during other non-fire related emergencies.
