The time for filing a certificate of nomination expired and only one candidate, Mr. Alton Hardee, Jr., filed said certificate. Therefore, the election has been cancelled and Mr. Hardee, Jr., is declared elected and shall be sworn in as Commissioner of Queenstown at the Commissioners November 2023 meeting.
