- The January Planning Commission meeting has been moved to January 10, 2024. Topics to be discussed include the Development Rights and Responsibilities Agreement for the Wheatlands Project and a proposed homeless shelter.
- Comcast has completed applications and begun the process of installing cable/internet service infrastructure in town to provide future service options to the town. Talkie Communications has also begun the application process to provide future internet services in town.

DELMARVA POWER LINE TRIMMING - Beginning in January, Delmarva Power will begin routine scheduled pruning of trees near power lines in Queenstown. This maintenance is performed as is necessary to prevent power outages due to tree branches contacting or falling on power lines.

LOST AND FOUND - Did you know the Town Office maintains a lost and found box? Current items in the lost and found include a ballcap, car key fob and a wallet. If you believe an item may be yours, please contact the Town Office to describe the item.

DID YOU KNOW?? - The Town Code and Town Property Maintenance Code require that all vehicles kept outdoors on properties within town must have current valid registration with tags plainly visible. Untagged vehicles may be kept within an enclosed structure such as a garage but must not be parked on roads, driveways, in yards, etc. The Town will be issuing warnings and fines for any untagged vehicle violations.
